MTSOA Online Meeting Minutes - 6:00 PM May 4, 2025

Board Members in attendance:

Tim Stewart – President

Tony Sheets - Treasurer

Tim Stewart called the meeting to order at 6:33PM.

Opening Remarks

- **Tim** welcomed attendees and acknowledged the last-minute rescheduling due to playoff game changes and personal travel.
- Thanked everyone for being flexible with the time change.

Dues & Financial Update

- Tony Sheets reported no new dues payments since the last meeting.
- Emphasized dues are \$50/year, due on January 1st.
- Encouraged all members to pay promptly to avoid burdening the association.
- Current balance: \$7,381.43

Arbiter Reports & Disciplinary Issues

- Reports must be filed even if there are no incidents ("No incidents" is sufficient).
- Emphasis on submitting red card and caution reports.
- **State-level consequence:** A referee was suspended for a year for failure to submit reports.
- Coaches, ADs, and principals contact TSSAA directly reporting protects officials.
- For **TACS** (Christian School) games, reports go only to Coz not the state.

Weather Delay Policy

- Golden rule: If you see lightning or hear thunder, leave the field immediately and wait 30 minutes.
- Applies even if lightning is beyond the 10-mile policy used by schools.
- Athletic trainers' decisions must be followed.
- Note in Arbiter: Time of delay, score, red/yellow cards, and restart procedure.
- Game becomes official only after 40 minutes (halftime).
- If called at halftime: score stands as final.

Overtime & Postseason Procedures

- Overtime format: Two 10-minute periods, not golden goal.
- Substitution rules apply in **last 5 minutes** of **second overtime period**.
- If still tied, proceed to **penalty kicks**.

Penalty Kick Procedures

- Anyone listed on the roster may take a kick (must be eligible and in uniform).
- If added late, note it in Arbiter and unusual situation report.
- Kicks are taken at a single selected goal; no coin toss required.
- Spectators must be cleared from behind the goal.

Order and Rotation:

- First set: 5 kickers per team.
- Second set: New 5 kickers (no repeats from 1st set).
- Third set and beyond: Repeats allowed, must rotate every 5.

Cautions During Kicks:

- **Before kick:** Player misses that round.
- After kick: Player skips next full round (i.e., if kicked in round 1 and cautioned, can't kick until round 16).
- Keeper cautioned: Must sit out next kicker.

Infractions:

- If no forward motion on the kick → indirect free kick for defending team.
- Encroachment: Depends on who violates.
 - o **Both teams:** Retake.
 - Defense: Retake if goal not scored.
 - Attackers: Indirect kick or retake.
- Goalkeeper violations: NFHS requires a retake, even if it didn't affect the outcome (unlike IFAB).

Clock Management & Crew Responsibility

- Clock should match referee's time; if not, ref should keep time on their watch and notify teams.
- Center & ARs must work as a team to ensure proper clock stoppage.
- **Stop clock** for: goals, injuries, cards, PKs, and as directed by the referee (e.g., crossing arms).
- **Pregame talk** with scorekeeper is essential: review stoppage/restart timing, especially for drop balls and throw-ins.
- Overtime timing: **5-minute break** between regulation and OT, **2-minute break** between OT halves.

Miscellaneous

- Emphasis on shin guard compliance and language enforcement, especially during playoffs.
- Players frequently ask to use illegal guards referees must remain firm.
- Reminder that NOSCAE stamp is the standard for legal shin guards.

Closing

- Tim thanked everyone for their time and flexibility.
- Recording will be made available.
- Encouraged members to ask questions anytime and review pages 77 & 92 of the NFHS rulebook.
